Lakeside Arts Foundation Chalk This Way Festival 2019 Guidelines

*Please return completed pre-registration entry form to Lakeside Arts Foundation, P.O. Box 560532, The Colony, TX 75056 or online at www.chalkthisway.org. Mailed contest entry fees MUST BE IN FORM OF CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY and securely attached to the entry form. Please do not mail cash.

Entry fees are payable day of event by cash, cashier's check, money order, or debit card (no personal checks on event day). Please make out check, cashier's check, or money order to Lakeside Arts Foundation, P.O. Box 560532.

Artists may not submit more than one work of art. Small groups of 4 or fewer may work on one image. Entries must be exclusively the work of the contestant(s) and may not contain or depict any copyrighted materials.

All Artwork must be contained within the designated 6 x 6' area. Artists wishing to do a group work larger than 6 x 6' must contact LAF prior to the event to make arrangements and must pay for the number of spaces used.

A detailed Concept Rendering must be sent in with the entry form, or may be submitted with the form on the day of the event. A discount is given for pre-registration.

All artwork must be family-appropriate and may not contain images of violence, profanity, obscenity, or inflammatory material (political, religious, etc.). Lakeside Arts Foundation reserves the right to reject entries for any reason including, but not limited to use of inappropriate subject matter.

Photos of artwork may be posted on the Chalk This Way Facebook page at the close of the festival and posted in the local newspaper the week following the event.

Board members of Visual Art League or board members of Lakeside Arts Foundation and immediate family members of the board of directors are ineligible for any contest prizes but may participate in the exhibition only (non-judged) areas.

By entering this activity, the artist gives LAF permission to photograph and publish all artwork created.

Other than chalk, which is provided by LAF, artists must provide their own supplies and materials. Artists are encouraged to wear sunscreen, sun-protective clothing, closed-toe shoes, and a hat. You may also bring an umbrella or small canopy to cover your art, but the canopy must be removed when the artwork is completed. Do not wear clothing that you do not want to risk being stained or ruined. Chalk art is messy.
